


Figure 4. LY294002 and rapamycin suppress S100A4-induced viability and migration of CRC cells. (A) Effects of LY294002 and rapamycin on S100A4-induced viability of SW480 and LoVo cells were detected by MTT assay. * $P < 0.05$ vs S100A4 group. (B) Effects of LY294002 and rapamycin on S100A4-induced migration of SW480 and LoVo cells were detected by transwell assay, $\times 200$. * $P < 0.05$, ** $P < 0.01$ vs S100A4 group.

In our paper [1], Figure 4B should be corrected as follows.
